

Request for Inclusion on the Somali Cat Club Kitten List

The Somali Cat club runs a kitten list that exists to help members sell kittens. Many of the enquiries received are from people who know extremely little about the breed and they trust the Club to help them find a suitable kitten. Any breeders named from the Kitten List are seen by the potential buyers as being endorsed by the Club.

Therefore, for kittens to be placed on the Kitten List the breeder must read and abide by the rules and sign the declaration below annually

Breeder's Declaration

I/We wish to place kittens on the Somali Cat Club list and agree to abide by the following rules. I/We accept that the Somali Cat Club reserves the right to refuse the inclusion of any kittens bred by me/us on the Kitten List if I/we have been found to be in breach of any of the following rules:

1. *All kittens will have completed their primary vaccination course.*
2. *No kitten will leave the breeder's premises under the age of **thirteen** weeks.*
3. *No kitten will be knowingly sold for breeding if it has a fault which precludes it being shown, e.g., white locket, congenital deformity, etc.*
4. *The experience of prospective owners will be taken into careful consideration before a male kitten is sold as a potential stud (**three years' breeding experience advised**).*
5. *No queen under normal circumstances is to have more than **two** litters a year.*
6. *All purchasers will be provided with the relevant paperwork and a signed pedigree.*
