

PK DEFICIENCY TESTING FOR SOMALIS

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR SAMPLES SENT TO BRISTOL

1. Forms, information etc are obtainable from the Somali Cat Club Website (www.somalicatclub.com) or by sending an SAE to the Somali BAC Secretary, Anne Gregory, 52 Hempstead Road, Hempstead, Gillingham, Kent, ME7 3RF.
2. Do NOT let your vet send the tests to Andrea Harvey. They MUST be sent to the Langford Veterinary Diagnostics Laboratory,
3. If there are any queries about the results or payment, please contact the Langford Veterinary Diagnostics lab directly and not Andrea.
4. The Somali BAC forms are not required for tests sent to Langford, Bristol. GCCF accepts the Bristol submission form as that has all the required details and serves as the certificate. You will need to send a copy of the Bristol submission form to the GCCF when kittens/cats are registered.
5. Never send your results sheet to the GCCF, make sure you have copies to send and keep the original form safely.
6. Please read the submission forms carefully as there are some differences from earlier forms. The microchip number must be written on the sample tube as well as on the form, otherwise the lab will return the samples, which will result in a significant delay.
7. An SAE must be included for a copy of the results to be sent to you. Otherwise, your vets will receive the results by fax and you will not have the form to copy for the GCCF.
8. Remember, all samples should be sent, by your vet, to Langford Veterinary Diagnostics lab, University of Bristol Veterinary School, Langford, BS40 5DU.
